

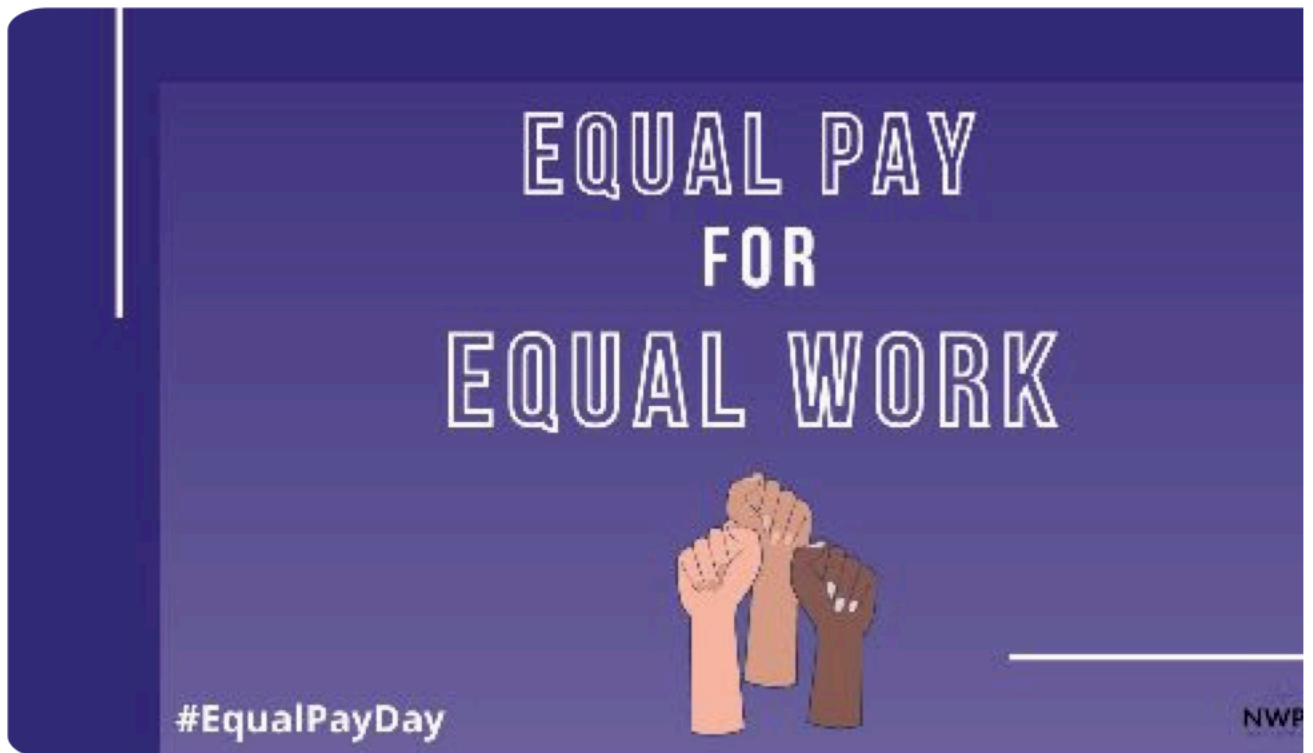

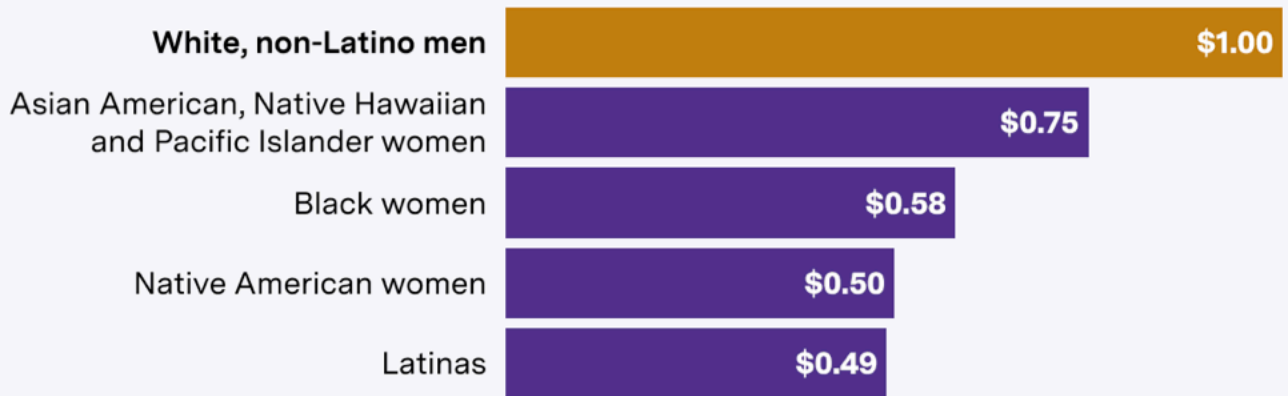


Today is **#EqualPayDay**, which symbolizes how far into the year wom have to work on average just to earn what the average man made the

previous year. The gender pay gap is yet another reminder of how women are impacted by inequality.

Equal pay for women of color is still a far-off goal

How much women of color earned on average for every dollar earned by non-Latino White men in 2021, by race or ethnic group

Averages based on median earnings for full- and part-time workers. Analysis based on 2021 U.S. Census data, except for Native American women whose most recent data was from 2020.

For women of color, **#EqualPayDay** falls later in the year.

For each \$1 earned by a White man:

- AAPI: 75 cents/May 3 (but longer for different disaggregated racial groups within the AAPI community)
- Black women: 58 cents/September 21
- Native American women: 50 cents/December 1
- Latinas: 49 cents/December 8

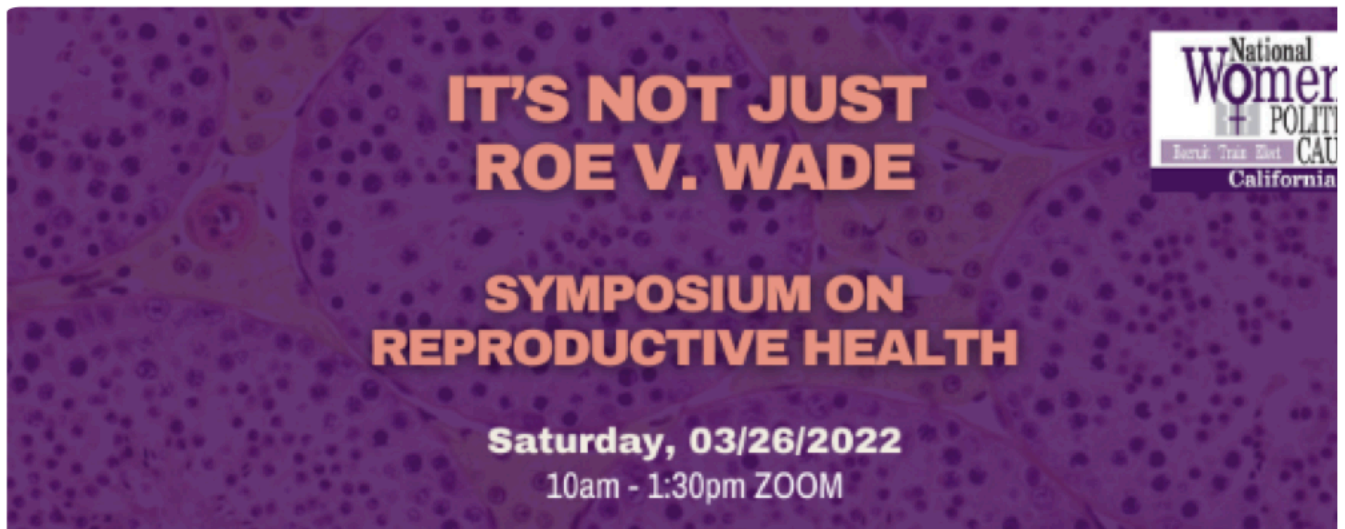
